Please note, effective Monday, March 30, 2020, the Imperial County Public Health Department will be closed to all walk-in services for the public. Department staff will be available to provide assistance by phone to members of the community who have questions related to any of the Department's essential services.

Phone assistance will be available Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 12:pm and 1:00 pm-5:00 pm. Assistance will not be available 12:00 pm to 1:00p.m., as the department will close for lunch. This shall remain in effect until further notice.
