EMS System Operations Supraglottic Airway Training Program and Eligibility

I. <u>Purpose:</u>

A. To establish a standardized Supraglottic (Perilaryngeal) Airway Adjunct Skills curriculum and program approval requirements

II. <u>Authority:</u>

- A. California Health and Safety Code Division 2.5: Emergency Medical Services [1797. 1799.207.]
- B. California Code of Regulations, Title 22. Social Security, Division 9. Prehospital Emergency Medical Services

III. <u>Definitions:</u>

A. Supraglottic (perilaryngeal) Airway Adjuncts: For the purpose of this policy, the term
"Perilaryngeal Airway Adjuncts" (PAA) includes both the Esophageal Tracheal Airway Device
(ETAD) and King Airway devices.

IV. <u>Policy:</u>

A. ICEMSA shall approve and designate PAA providers that meet established criteria.

V. Procedures:

- A. Documentation of current PAA program approval from ICEMSA.
- B. Enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with Imperial EMS for PAA services within the particular area of jurisdiction.
- C. Comply with the California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Section 100064(b).
