

County of Imperial  
Amended Order of the Health Officer

Pursuant to sections 101040, 120175, and 120175.5(b) of the California Health and Safety Code, the Imperial County Health Officer (“Health Officer”) hereby amends and supersedes the previous Health Officer Order dated April 9, 2020, as amended. The Health Officer **ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

Effective immediately, and continuing until rescinded, the follow will be in effect for the County of Imperial (“County”).

1. All residents of and visitors to the County shall abide by the June 18, 2020 Guidance for the Use of Face Coverings issued by the California Department of Public Health, as it may be amended or supplemented:

2. If any subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Order, or any application of it to any person, business, structure, gathering, or circumstance is held to be invalid, preempted, or unconstitutional by a decision of a court of competent jurisdiction, then such decision will not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Order.
3. This Order is issued in accordance with, and incorporates by reference any applicable federal, State, or local law, regulation rule, policies, or procedure related to COVID-19, including all Executive Orders issued by the Governor of the state of California, and all Health Orders issued by the State Public Health Officer for the state of California, as they may be amended or supplemented.
4. To protect the public’s health, the Health Officer may take additional action(s) for failure to comply with this Order. Violation of this Order is a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment, fine or both under sections 120295 et seq. of the California Health and Safety Code. Further, pursuant to sections 26602 and 41601 of the California Government Code, and section 101029 of the California Health and Safety Code, the Health Officer requests that the Sheriff and the Chiefs of Police in all cities located in the County ensure compliance with and enforcement of this Order.
5. This Order shall remain in effect until rescinded.
