

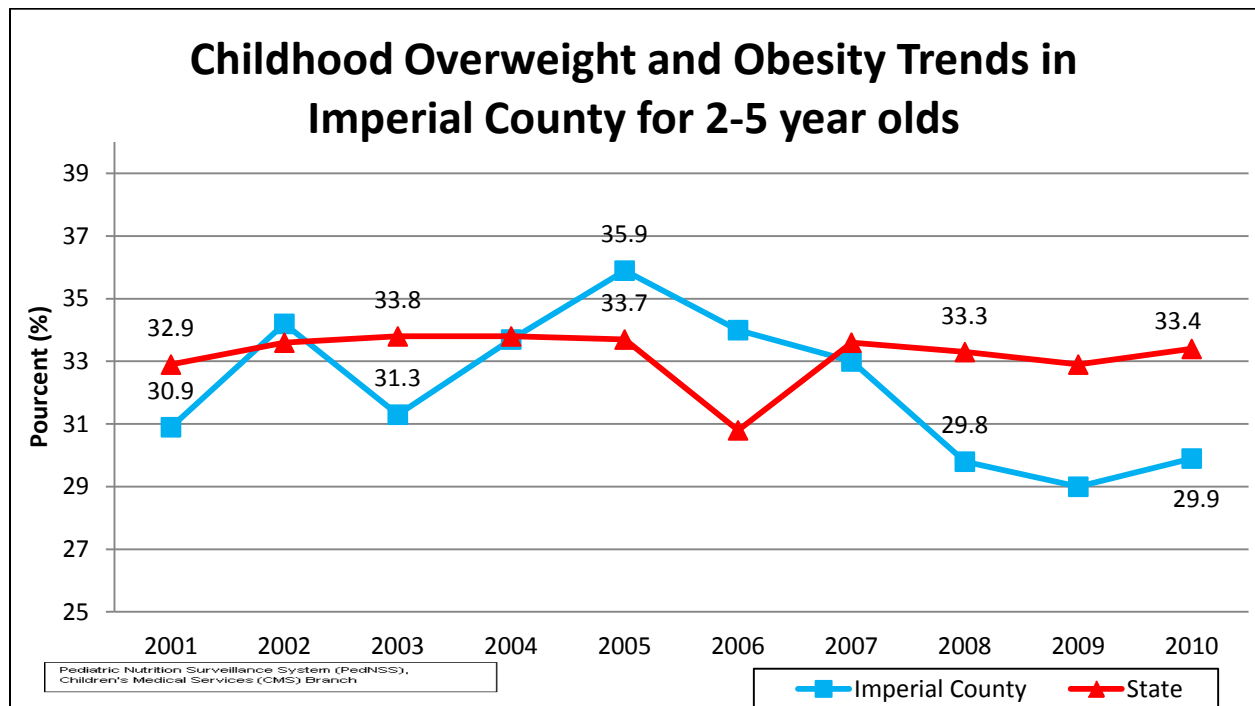
Overweight and obesity affect the quality of life of many people. In Imperial County obesity and overweight affect a large proportion of the population. The graph below illustrates the rates of childhood obesity and overweight in our population of children aged 2-5 years old. The data was collected through the Child Health Disability Prevention Program (CHDP) that many local providers participate in. The first graph is for children 2-5 years old and the second for children 5-20 years old. For both graphs, you can see the evolution of the obesity and overweight for Imperial County and the State of California.

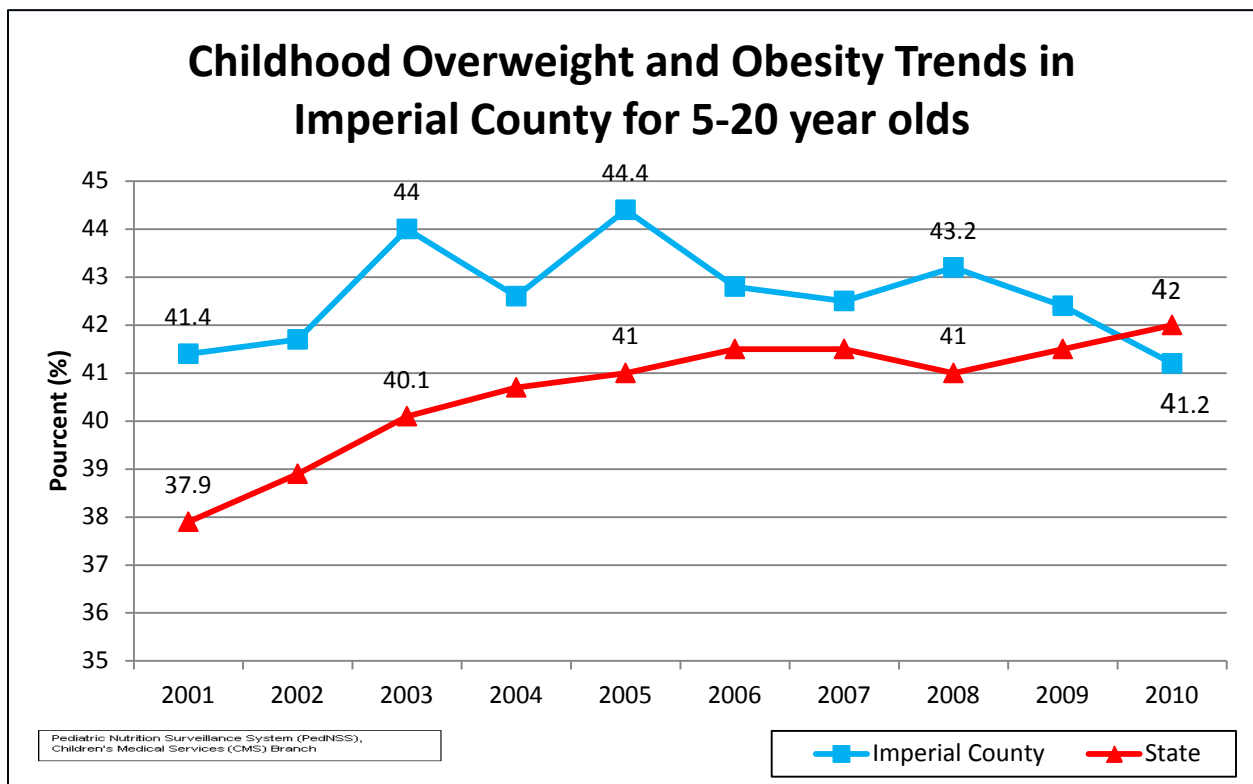
